**INVITATION TO BID FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR
DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS SYSTEM AND
DIGITAL ID SYSTEM PROJECT.**

The Government of The Gambia through the Ministry of Interior (MOI) hereby launches a competitive bidding process to procure a private partner to design, build, and transfer the National Identification Document Systems and Digital ID system project. Ministry of Interior's main objective is to contract a private partner who has the expertise, innovations, knowledge, and ability to develop a technology system or solutions for this undertaking.

The need for this proposed project is to design, build, and transfer the systems categorized into two phases:

- i) Development of National Identification Documents system (Phase I): That is capable of processing national identity documents, independent of third-party interference and operational government infrastructure. The initiative aims at enhancing the efficiency, security, and accessibility of services for citizens and residents alike.
- ii) Development of a Digital ID system (Phase II): To support self-sovereign digital identity and verifiable credential services. The DID System must adhere to principles of security, privacy, and convenience, ensuring trust and transparency in digital interactions.

In light of the above-mentioned, interested firms are invited to bid for the design, build, and transfer of the Ministry of Interior National Identification Document Systems and Digital ID system project. A complete set of the bidding documents will be supplied to the interested bidders upon payment of a **non-refundable fee of USD 10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Dollars)**.
